ADELAIDE TO HOST THE AUSTRALIAN INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION CONFERENCE IN 2023

The 36th annual Australian International Education Conference (AIEC) will be held at the Adelaide Convention Centre in October 2023, bringing together leading international education experts from around the globe.

Themed "International education: visionary and transformative", AIEC 2023 will explore the ways the international education sector continues to transform people, places and ideas that result in a better, more inclusive and connected world.

AIEC delegates will also discuss developments on the horizon and the strategies needed to meet the demands of an everchanging social, political and cultural landscape.

IDP Connect Chief Executive Officer, Simon Emmett said AIEC 2023 will provide a key forum for international education leaders to strengthen our sector and better support its students.

"It has been refreshing to return to an in-person conference for AIEC 2022, for the first time in three years, and witness the collective strength and forward-thinking of our sector. More than 1,700 delegates gathered in the Gold Coast this week – a testament to this year's theme of going "Beyond Borders".

"The pace of transformation and change is accelerating. Next year's conference will be a valuable opportunity to meet with peers and leaders again to collaborate and plan for a more inclusive, sustainable and connected world," Mr Emmett said.

"It is only fitting that next year's conference – celebrating visionary thinking and transformation – is held in Adelaide, the first Australian city to give women the vote, and recognise Indigenous land rights," he said.

Newly appointed IEAA President, Simon Ridings, said IEAA is looking forward co-hosting AIEC 2023 and reflecting on how the industry has evolved and transformed.

"As we've experienced this week, AIEC is an important opportunity for the industry to connect, collaborate and inspire. The International Education Association of Australia is excited to co-host the conference in 2023 and celebrate the progress and innovation with education leaders."

The announcement comes on the back of the successful AIEC 2022 held on the Gold Coast.

AIEC 2023 will be held from 10-13 October 2023 at the Adelaide Convention Centre. More than 1400 delegates, NGOs, government representatives and private providers are expected to attend a range of inperson, virtual and hybrid sessions, workshops and roundtables.

The conference will be jointly hosted by IDP Education and the International Education Association of Australia.
